DESPITE THE IMPACTS AND RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, THE OUTLOOK FOR THE UPPER SPENCER GULF AND ITS MAJOR INDUSTRIES REMAINS STRONG.

GFG ALLIANCE

WHYALLA STEEL TRANSFORMATION.

GFG reaffirmed its commitment to upgrading the ageing Whyalla steelworks it bought in 2017. On June 10th GFG announced its updated Whyalla GREENSTEEL Transformation Plan in a major milestone for the business, as it seeks to secure the long-term future of its South Australian based steelworks.

It revealed further plans for a sophisticated Electric Arc Furnace and a Direct Reduced Iron facility to produce low-emission GREENSTEEL from GFG's abundant South Australian magnetite resource and domestic steel scrap. The new DRI plant will be fed by Natural Gas, in time transitioning to green hydrogen produced from GFG's own renewable energy projects including Cultana.



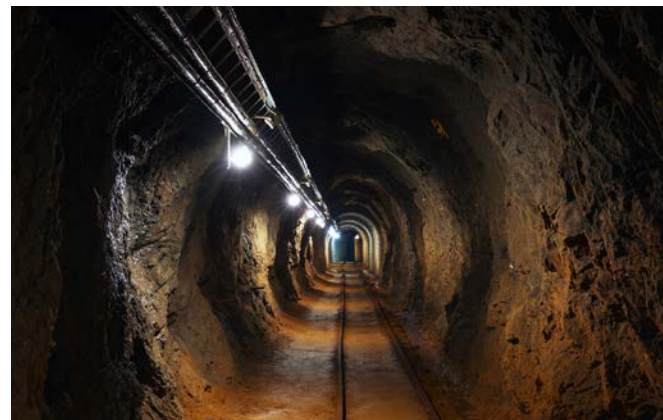
SIMEC MINING

(PART OF THE GFG ALLIANCE GROUP)

SIMEC Mining's operations incorporate the Iron Baron, Iron Knob and South Middleback Ranges mine sites. The SIMEC port facility has been chosen as the preferred location through which to ship copper concentrate from OZ Minerals' new Carrapateena mine.

OZ MINERALS

Life of Province Plan Scoping Study has been undertaken to determine the potential of the Carrapateena Province for future mining opportunities following Block Cave 2. OZ Minerals continues its commitment to local supplier engagement across the Upper Spencer Gulf.



ELECTRANET

The Australian Energy Regulator (AER) has released ElectraNet's application to approve the funding for the new transmission line proposed for the Eyre Peninsula, known as Eyre Peninsula Link. \$290 M project cost.

ElectraNet will build a new double-circuit 132 kV transmission line from Cultana to Port Lincoln with the ability to upgrade the Cultana to Yadnarie section to 275 kV in the future.

Major construction works include upgrades to transmission substations at Port Lincoln, Cultana, Yadnarie, Wudinna and Middleback, and a new 270km transmission line. About 200 jobs are expected to be created during construction.

DPTI

The Port Wakefield to Port Augusta Alliance (PW2PA) a consortium of CPB Contractors Pty Ltd, Aurecon Pty Ltd and GHD Pty Ltd, and DPTI continue to work on the Joy Baluch AM Bridge Duplication and Port Wakefield Overpass and Highway Duplication projects, worth more than \$400M, with design works progressing. Major construction for the project is expected to commence in the second half of 2020, with completion expected in 2022. McMahon Services has been given the opportunity to deliver key aspects of work under the Alliance.



BHP

The South Australian Government has advanced BHP's proposal to increase copper production at the Olympic Dam mine from 200,000 to 350,000 tonnes per annum. The Olympic Dam expansion is also being fast-tracked as part of a Federal Government plan to boost employment and reduce the length and severity of the coronavirus-induced recession. The expansion has been granted Major Development status by the state government and is expected to support up to 1800 jobs during construction and an additional 600 ongoing operational roles thereafter.



LEIGH CREEK ENERGY

Continues to work towards the commercialisation of their in-situ gasification project, raising funds to progress the company's Leigh Creek Energy Project (LCEP) through the next stages of commercialisation. This includes geotechnical evaluation and pre-feasibility studies. The LCEP aims to commercialise the Maiden 2P Reserve certification of 1,153PJ – similar in size to BHP's East Coast gas reserves.



STRZELECKI TRACK UPGRADE

The Strzelecki Track is a 472 km unsealed rural road that links the towns of Lyndhurst to Innamincka in the north east of South Australia. It is a vital supply link for major oil and gas facilities located near Moomba, in the Cooper Basin, and is an essential transport corridor for outback communities, tourism and pastoralists. In June 2020, the South Australian Government announced it is investing \$10 million to seal the first 50-kilometres of the 472-kilometre Strzelecki Track, beginning immediately north of Lyndhurst. The project is expected to commence in the third quarter of 2020, with completion expected in the last quarter of 2021, weather permitting.
